
IT SUPPORT SPECIALIST

SECURITY SPECIALIST

NETWORK SPECIALIST

Network specialists design, install, manage and troubleshoot computer networks, ensuring they run efficiently and securely. They handle tasks such as monitoring network performance, resolving connectivity issues, and implementing security measures to protect against cyber threats.

COMPUTER SYSTEMS ANALYST

Average Salary: \$32.00/hour | \$66,571/year Education Required: Associate Degree Time to complete education: 2 years

Computer Systems Analysts improve and implement new software and system designs. They may research incoming technologies and consider possible implementation. Once a new software is introduced to their company, they are required to train employees and write instruction manuals on proper technological operation.



SOFTWARE DEVELOPER

Software Developers design, program, and improve software applications. They may be required to meet with clients to gather preferences for an application's final design. Developers test and adjust their application's specific code to ensure the desired level of functionality.

Education Options: Certificate or Associate Degree

Time to complete education: 1-2 years

Database Administrators oversee database updates, maintenance, design, security, and growth. They are responsible for archiving data, initiating data changes, and training others in database management. They may be required to assign specific tasks to other technology experts.

COMPUTER APPLICATIONS SPECIALIST

Average Salary: \$33.12/hour | \$68,890/year Education Options: Associate Degree Time to complete education: 2 years

Computer Applications Specialists schedule appointments, answer phone calls, provide technical information to customers, install software, and repair computer equipment. They use their research skills to collect data and prepare important documents for presentations to superiors.
